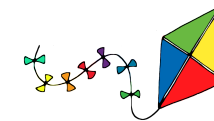

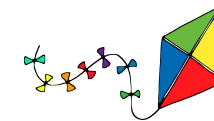
## What will my child learn at school this term?

### Homework Opportunities

- Reading Eggs - there are series of books and related questions to support reading development appropriate to reading age. The tasks should be accessed regularly across the year. Learners also have access to a range of books through the classroom library and can take these home at any time and review them in their planners
- Reading & Spelling tasks - will be assigned on Reading Eggs every week. Learners will have to complete assigned tasks prior to accessing the other facilities on Reading Eggs.
- J2 Blast through HWB is a great way to practise quick mental recall.
- After each numeracy learning block, a homework task will be assigned to support learners in the elements they may have found challenging. All class-based tasks can be accessed at home for revision purposes if required.
- Project work - this will be set throughout the year for pupils to complete at home.
- Additional numeracy and literacy tasks will be allocated where necessary.
