LANGUAGE, LITERACY AND COMMUNICATION	Share books, songs and rhymes linked to dragons, castles, knights and princesses. Retell stories in the Puppet Theatre. Begin to mark make/write some letters through their play. Listen to and follow instructions accurately Listen to and join in with Nursery Rhymes. Sing familiar and new Welsh Songs with actions. Practice and learn new vocabulary - greetings, feelings, numbers Follow simple instructions in Welsh		
MATHEMATICS AND NUMERACY	Sing, watch and join in with number rhymes on the IWB. Recognise/Read Numbers 0-5 and beyond Order numbers 0-5 and beyond. Sort coins by colour, shape or size. Name 2D shapes and recognise in the Nursery environment. Recognise and copy repeating patterns. Begin to mark make/Write some numbers through their play.		
HUMANITIES	Celebrate Wales - traditions from the past and present day Finding out about the Chinese New Year and participate in activities. Dragons in the past.		
SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY	Use the digital technology to take photos and enhance our learning. Use Bee Bots.		
HEALTH & WELLBEING	Develop fine motor skills: zips/buttons on clothes, use of scissors. Become independent in their personal hygiene and care Develop an awareness of the behavioural expectations of Nursery. Show an interest in cultural differences. Demonstrate a caring nature towards peers and take turns. Physical activities - outdoors Values Education - LOVE		
EXPRESSIVE ARTS	Large Scale Art - outdoors, Paint dragons. Use junk modelling to create artwork. Create a dragon Dance. Experiment with the musical instruments Enjoy singing familiar songs.
