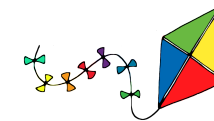
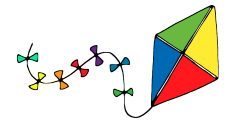

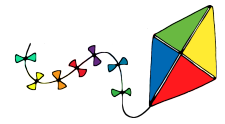


What will my child learn at school this term?

SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY	<p>Properties of materials - sorting, grouping and comparing using the appropriate scientific language Plan investigations to a range of problems and then collect and record information to find answers. Electricity and circuits Coding and Google Slides</p>
HEALTH & WELLBEING	<p>Caring for the planet. Take responsibilities for their own actions and understand for every action there will be a reaction. E.g. Cause and effect: dropping litter, wasting water. SRE - Keeping private parts private, saying 'no', keeping secrets and keeping clean Values - Determination and Resilience - using stories, short films, songs and discussions. Sun Safety Games and P.E.</p>
EXPRESSIVE ARTS	<p>Accompaniments - exploring percussion instruments, glockenspiels and ukuleles, singing in rounds, responding to different genres and styles of music e.g. classical, African, pop Designing, creating and evaluating model clay creatures. Multimedia project.</p>
