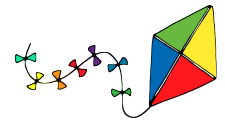

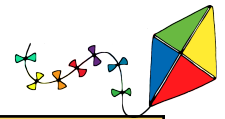
Reception - Summer Term 2026		CONTEXT: Down on the Farm

What will my child learn at school through this context?

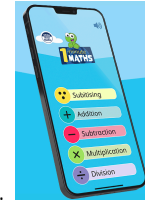
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Capacity- Helping the ‘farmer’ with milk quantities, farm feed, measuring to build fences animal homes etc
HUMANITIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Farming and farm machinery in the past. ● Create a map of a farm. ● Celebrating outdoor learning and Earth Day. ● Trip to Cefn Mably Farm. ● No Outsiders - Choosing and liking different things is ok, we can still be friends! We are similar and we are different in many ways e.g. hair, eye colour, skin colour, hobbies ● Role Play - Farm Shop
SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Learning to look after animals. ● Grow produce as they would on the Farm- Gardening. ● Set up a Farm Shop. ● Problem solving - TASC-create a new ramp for the Hen House. ● Collecting data of our favourite farm animals and representing it as bar graphs online. ● Using the ipads for creative, maths and Literacy opportunities ● Planting seeds and growing vegetables for our farm shop.
HEALTH & WELLBEING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Learning to look after living things, plants and animals. ● Learn about healthy eating linked to the Farm Shop. ● Farm Trip - Exploring a new environment. ● SRE- Sun Safety. ● Healthy Eating week. ● Learning about different cultures; Islam, Christianity, ● Values - Determination, Courage ● PE - Athletics, striking and fielding. Sports Day activities.
EXPRESSIVE ARTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Create music and dance linked to the Farm. ● Paint animals from memory and imagination. ● Drama - Retell the story of ‘The Little Red Hen’ using props. ● Create a farm using junk modelling. ● Large Scale Art - Creating a Farm ● Drama- Performance- ‘Seed song’ and ‘Little Red Hen’ ● Making our own musical instruments.
