SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY	Learning about plants and flowers and how to grow them. Minibeast hunt. Observing the weather. Explore animals that live in the garden.		
HEALTH & WELL BEING	Planning food for a picnic/learning about healthy food. Making food in the mud kitchen.		
EXPRESSIVE ARTS	Making garden music. Painting flowers. Learning about famous artist who paint flowers.
