Keeping Our Children Safe!

We kindly remind all parents, carers, and children to always use the designated pedestrian walkway when entering and exiting the school grounds.

School Lunch Orders & Reducing

Food Waste!

To help our school day run smoothly and support our environmental goals, please remember that all school lunches must be ordered by the morning deadline.

- **Minimising Food Waste:** When lunches are not pre-ordered, it makes it incredibly difficult for our kitchen team to gauge quantities accurately, leading to unnecessary food waste. We are working hard with our pupils to discuss sustainability, and managing our kitchen waste is a huge part of this.
- **Discuss Options at Home:** Please take a few moments to look at the menu and discuss the choices with your child before school.
- **No Changes Without Consent:** To ensure children receive exactly what their parents have approved (and to safely manage any dietary requirements or allergies), we are strictly unable to change a child's lunch option at the hatch without direct parental consent.
