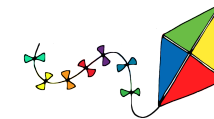
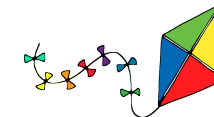

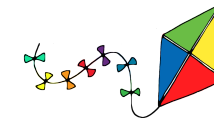
Reading - Appropriate books are available for children to read on Reading Eggs.
